Grades:

Course Description:

Students will delve into a comprehensive study of four, major literary works- this study will include written and oral analytical presentations highlighting historical significance, as well as group discussions, oral readings and weekly quizzes. Students will be required to keep a vocabulary journal as well as complete weekly homework assignments. By the end of the school year, your student will have an enhanced sense of literary culture, greater oral reading skills and research capabilities.
