Class Curriculum: Institute for Excellence in Writing

Class Cost: \$45 per student per month

Supplies Needed: A three-ring notebook with pockets on the inside flaps, pen or pencil

Grade Level: 4th – 6th graders (4th graders should be strong for their age in Language Arts)

Minimum/Maximum number of student: 6/12

Description: This class is for all young writers. It will concentrate on Structure and Style in a format that guides the students through the whole process of writing from brainstorming and note taking, to rough drafts, editing and the final product to be shared in class. (Yes, elements of public speaking will also be learned in this class!)

A variety of writing experiences await your student. They will learn summarizing techniques to avoid plagiarism. They will have a writing checklist to help enhance all their writing, from reports to creative writing. Writing non-fiction as well as fiction will appeal to all interest levels.

This course will prepare elementary age students with writing skills far above their peers and provides a solid foundation for high school. Students will experience their competency in writing grow as they learn the precise skill of this course, while retaining their individuality and creativity.

At the end of the year, students will have a writing notebook filled with writing tools they will be able to use for years to come.
