**Grades:** 4-6

**Prerequisites:** none

**Materials:** 3-ring binder; small dry-erase board (+ markers)

**Class size:** minimum 5, max 10

**Class Fees:** \$20 per student per month, **Materials:** \$10/semester

**Synopsis:** A “hands-on” math class for students interested in using their math skills while acting as Jr. zoologists, ecologists, botanists, earth scientists, physicists, and environmentalists. Graphing, probabilities, fractions, introduction to algebra and formulas, word problems, thinking skills and logic will be covered in an unusual, but fun way.
