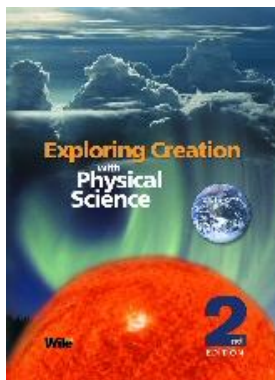


Exploring Creation with Physical Science

2nd Edition



8th Grade

Course Description: This course is designed to be the last science course the student takes before high school biology. Thus, we generally recommend it as an 8th grade course. **However, your student can also use it for their 9th grade course work.** The text discusses such topics as the atmosphere, the hydrosphere, weather, the structure of the earth, environmentalism, the physics of motion, Newton's Laws, gravity, and astrophysics. The author especially concentrates on the myths generated by the hysterical environmentalist movement. There are many hands-on experiments to do, and they all use household chemicals and supplies. It is an excellent course for preparing the student to take a college-prep high school science curriculum.

Class Description: This class will be taught as a **co-op class**. This means that each mom, that has one or more children participating in this class, will be responsible for teaching at least two modules of the course book. The number of classes each mom will be responsible for depends on the number of families that participate. The textbook is divided into 16 modules. We will have two classes per module. The textbook should be read at home prior to the corresponding class time. The class time is used for review, activities and experiments.

Class Fees: Since this is a **co-op** class, there is no monthly fee. However, you will need to purchase the following: **Physical Science 2nd Edition Textbook**, **Physical Science 2nd Edition Solutions and Test Manual**, and the **Physical Science 2nd Edition Multimedia Companion CD-ROM**.
